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**Thompson Speedway Lodging and Restaurant Info – 3-1-16**

The following information has been assembled by Bob O'Meara, member of PCA/NER, VSCCA, VRG for club members who wish to find lodging and restaurants nearby the Track.

**Comfort Inn, 16 Tracy Rd, Dayville/Killingly, CT:**

This is the closest available motel to the Track – right off Rt 395 and only about 9-10 mi from the Track. This is a nice, clean, modern motel with ample parking.

Request the Track Rate and give the club name: PCA/NER, VRG, VSCCA for discounted rate quoted below.

Description: 25 rooms available in block until 30 days prior to arrival date  
2 Queen or 1 King beds – non-smoking - \$109/121/night  
1 King Suite or 2 Double with pull out couch - \$124/136/night  
TV, coffee, wi-fi, some have fridges and microwaves - ask  
Full breakfast included  
No history of bugs/bedbugs  
Ample parking  
Gold Eagle restaurant/pub next door – modern, clean, pub/seafood etc.  
moderately priced, entertainment Fri (Kareoke) and Sat (band)  
The Lake Tavern, .5 mi, 1717 Upper Maple St (see below info)

**Directions to Comfort Inn:**

Rt 395 N or S to Exit 43/ Attawagan/Ballouville  
End of ramp turn West, go .1 or .2 mi  
R onto Tracy St. at light  
Motel is on the right

**Directions to Track from Motel:**

L out parking lot to light  
L at light to Rt 395 N ramp on L  
395N about 6 mi +-  
Take Exit 50/Rt 200 CT/North Grosvernordale & Thompson  
End of ramp take Rt 200 to Thompson Center to stop sign/blinking light – 3 mi  
At light take L onto Rt 193 for 1.5 mi  
Where 193 curves to the L, take a R onto Thompson Rd (actually straight) – 0.6 mi

Turn R into Speedway main entrance  
All vehicles must stop at first building to sign in  
Proceed on driveway to track and paddock – obey the lights at the overpass!!

Reverse directions to return to motel. No, I'm not going to print them out.....geez! You guys drive over 100 mph – really?!

***Note: The Exit numbers on Rt 395 have been re-numbered to match the miles of the highway, so Exit 43 is also mile 43 of the road, etc.***

There is also a great small restaurant near the motel called **The Lake Tavern**, 1717 Upper Maple St., Dayville, CT. This is where the locals go, and all the food is prepared from fresh food – no frozen. It's small, but they say the food is great! If you go- bring your pickup, shotgun and plaid shirt.....and don't forget to ask in the bar how to get the free jello shots!

Directions: L out motel parking lot to light, then R across RR tracks, then immediate L on Upper Maple St. – go about .5 mi – restaurant on R. If you continue on this road (by the lake) it comes out on Rt 101 in Dayville – take a L at the T on 101 and proceed to the shopping mall in Killingly/Dayville for shopping or additional restaurants. To return to motel you can get on Rt 395 N and go one exit to Exit 43 etc.

Zip's Diner at the intersection of Rt 395 and Rt 101 is a great place for breakfast they say – good food all around!
